It was last owned by The Los Angeles Convention & Visitors Authority, which decided to demolish it with the aim of making way for an La Hollywood Global Business District, including the decline in popularity of the property, increased competition from newer resorts on the Las Vegas Strip, and financial difficulties faced by the owners.
