<p>International multi-sport events for disabled athletes</p>

<p>The Paralympic sports comprise all the sports contested in the Summer and Winter Paralympic Games.</p>  
<p>As of 2020, the Summer &#128273; Paralympics included 22 sports and 539 medal events,[1] and the Winter Paralympics include 5 sports and disciplines and about 80 &#128273; events.</p>  
<p>[2] The number and kinds of events may change from one Paralympic Games to another.</p>  
<p>The Paralympic Games are a major &#128273; international multi-sport event for athletes with physical disabilities or intellectual impairments.</p>  
<p>This includes athletes with mobility disabilities, amputations, blindness, and cerebral &#128273; palsy.</p>  
<p>Paralympic sports refers to organized competitive sporting activities as part of the global Paralympic movement.</p>  
<p>These sports are organized and run &#128273; under the supervision of the International Paralympic Committee and other international sports federations.</p>  
<p>History [ edit ]</p>  
<p>Archery: Lindsey Carmichael from the &#128273; United States, at the 2008 Paralympic Games in Beijing.</p>  
<p>Organized sport for persons with physical disabilities developed out of rehabilitation programs.</p>  
<p>Following &#128273; World War II, in response to the needs of large numbers of injured ex-service members and civilians, sport was introduced &#128273; as a key part of rehabilitation.</p>  
<p>Sport for rehabilitation grew into recreational sport and then into competitive sport.</p>  
<p>The pioneer of this &#128273; approach was Ludwig Guttmann of the Stoke Mandeville Hospital in England.</p>  
<p>In 1948, while the Olympic Games were being held in &#128273; London, England, he organized a sports competition for wheelchair athletes at Stoke Mandeville.</p>  
<p>This was the origin of the Stoke Mandeville &#128273; Games, which evolved into the modern Paralympic Games.[3]</p>  
<p>Organization [ edit ]</p>  
<p>Globally, the International Paralympic Committee is recognized as the leading &#128273; organization, with direct governance of nine sports, and responsibility over the Paralympic Games and other multi-sport, multi-disability events.</p>
