Roulette is one of the popular wheel game played across the casinos all over the world. The wheels of the European and American Roulette have been in the game since hundreds of years, whereas the modern wheels are more reliable and consistent. The rules, functions, operations remain the same since the 18th century. Though it may be hard to discover the pattern of numbers on the wheel, they are not distributed randomly. Instead, a certain specific order of number is followed at most casinos, about existing rules, generally beginning from a single zero. But the pattern from single zero to double zero wheels is very different. European Roulette Wheel As per standard rules, the European roulette table has 37 numbers, starting from 0, then 1 to 36 on which bets are placed. The wheel is divided into two colors, red and black. Hence, the red and black numbers change. To the right of zero in the arc, there are nine small numbers in black (2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18) and outside. Similarly, to the left of zero, there are nine numbers in black, (20, 22, 24, 26, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36) and outside. These are the probable chances on which the ball will land. There are rules which state that three standard arcs in the wheel where players place bets. Rules and How to Play If you are wondering how to play European roulette, you have come to the right place.
